	Smoking/Tobacco- NKU is a tobacco-free campus. Tobacco products are therefore prohibited in all interior/e building space, outside ground areas, walkways and parking structures, indoor/outdoor athletic facilities, and vehicles. Smoking and tobacco use are also prohibited in all interior/exterior residential areas. Fire Safety Equipment- Smoke detectors, fire extinguishers, and exit lights are important parts of the fire safety living community. Destruction or vandalism of fire safety equipment is prohibited and violators will face sig disciplinary action, including a \$100 fine per resident, suspension from residential living or the University. False are subject to a \$200 fine. False alarms include burned food, intentionally pulled alarms, etc.		
	Candles - ALL candles, whether lit or unlit are prohibited (this	s includes wickless candles).	
	Compliance with the University Staff— Residents are expected to comply with all directives from University staff to include the University Housing staff. Failure to comply will result in significant disciplinary action. NKU All Cardl/Resident Room Keys- Residents are prohibited from lending one's assigned residence hall keys and NKU All Cards to guests or other residents of housing. Individuals in possession of keys and NKU All Cards that are no assigned to them will have these items confiscated by University Housing staff members or the University Police. External Doors- Specific external doors are accessible with the use of your room key. The forced opening of all othe external doors is prohibited. Door propping is not permitted. Door propping results in a fine of \$25.00 for first propped door distributed equally among the responsible residents. Fines are subject to increase with repeated incidents. Mail Notification/Email Notification- University Housing will distribute important and time sensitive housing information to residents via campus mail and/or email. Residents must regularly check NKU email accounts and campus mailboxes. Noise- Each resident has the right to enjoy a quality living environment, thus noise that impacts other residents is prohibited. Courtesy hours are in effect 24 hours a day. Common Area Damage and Group Billing- In the event that there is damage to the common area of a building, floor or wing, NKU will work to identify the responsible resident(s). If the responsible resident(s) cannot be identified, Housing will bill all residents of the building, floor, or wing. Residents should report alleged vandalism acts to the Office of University Housing and/or the University Police as quickly as possible. Pets- Pets, other than fish, are prohibited. Fish must be contained in aquariums that do not exceed 10 gallons.
