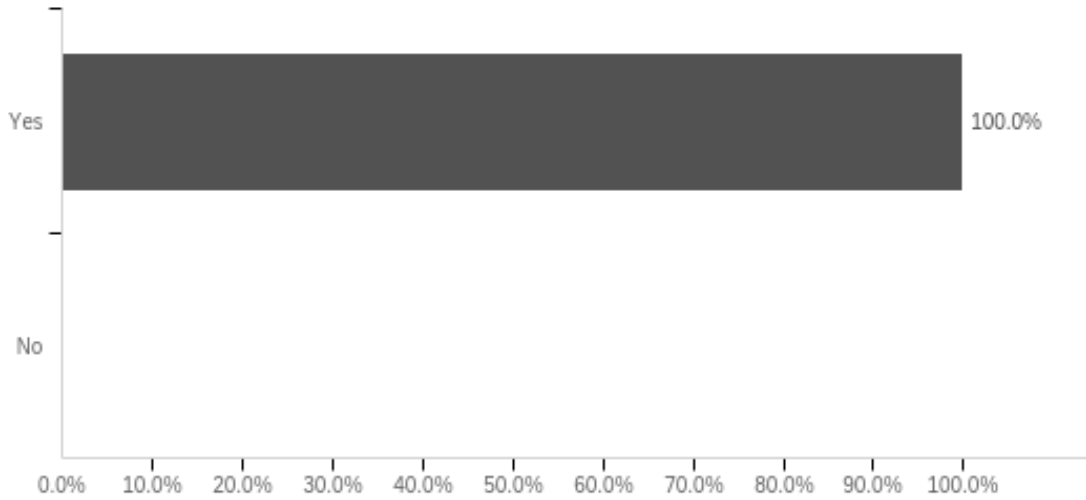


# S2S Program Evaluation 2023

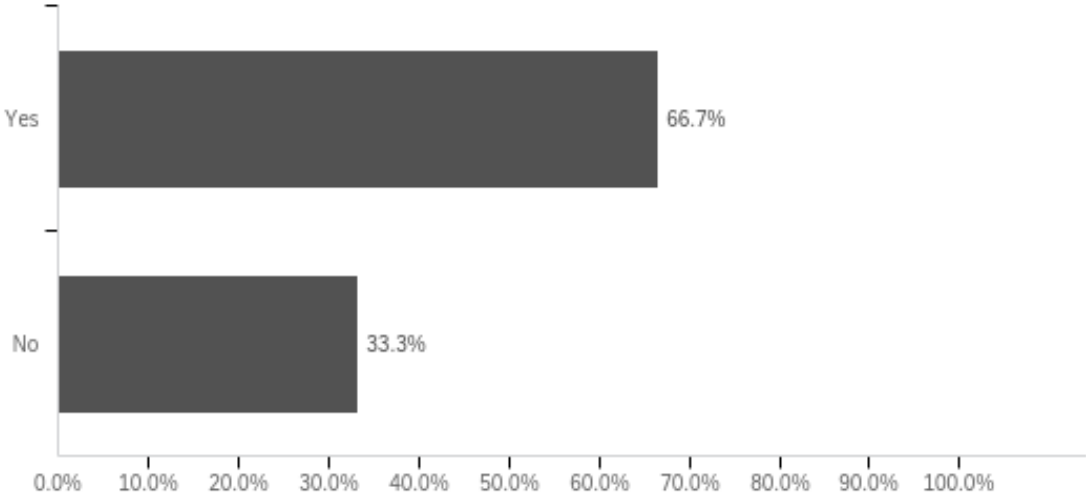

Computer Science & Mathematics; Thinking of gaining internship experience in the future

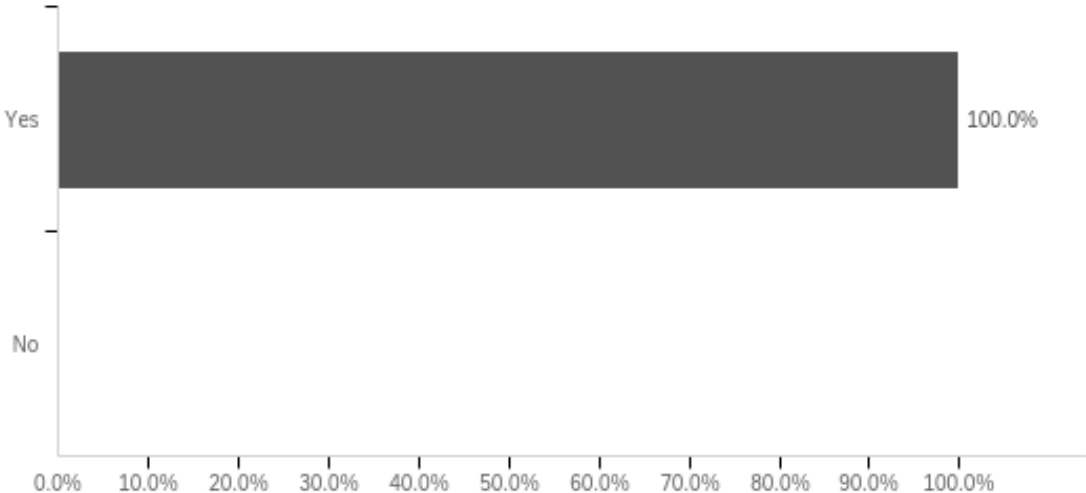

I have gained a relationship w/mentors, students, and faculty.

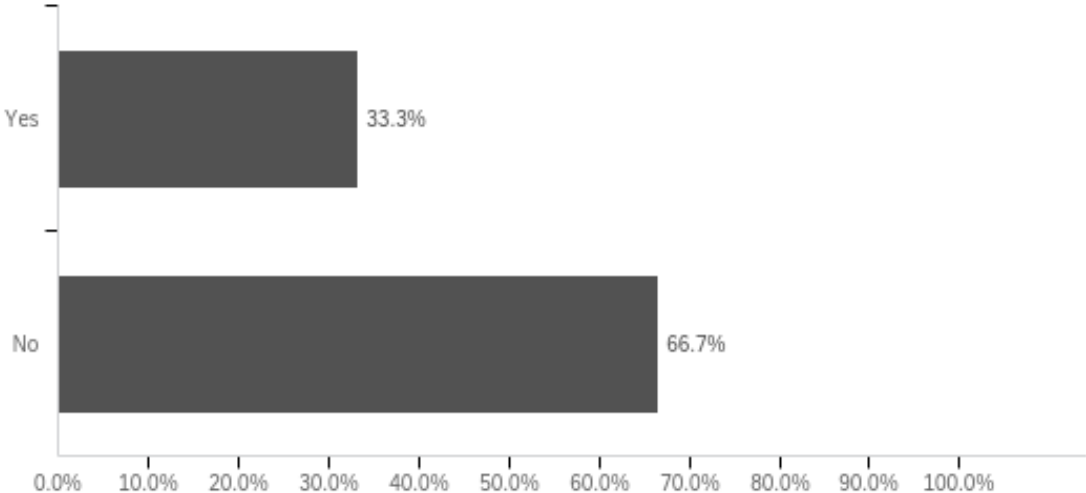

S2S helped me obtain intention when searching for my career path/future

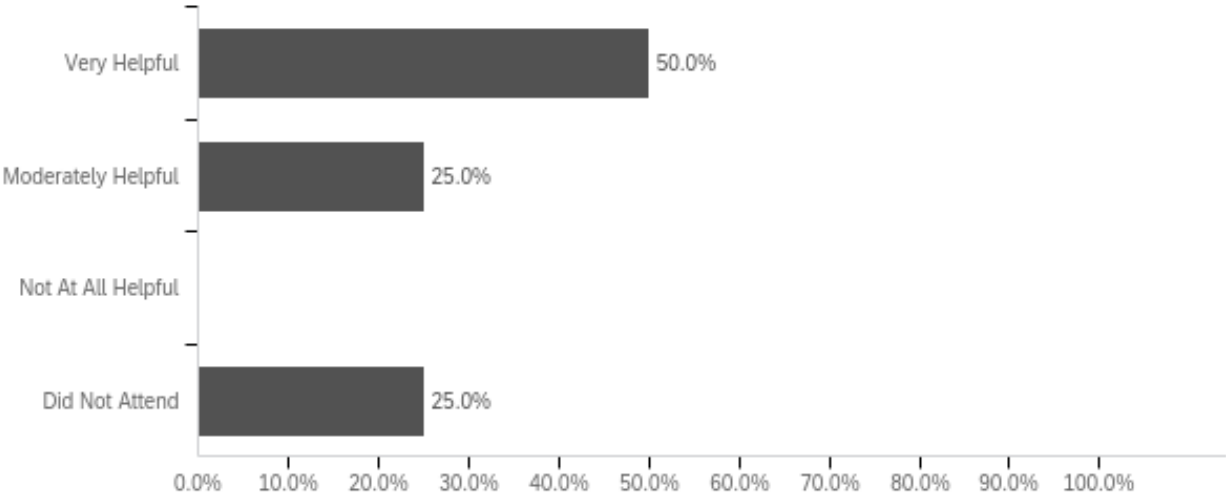

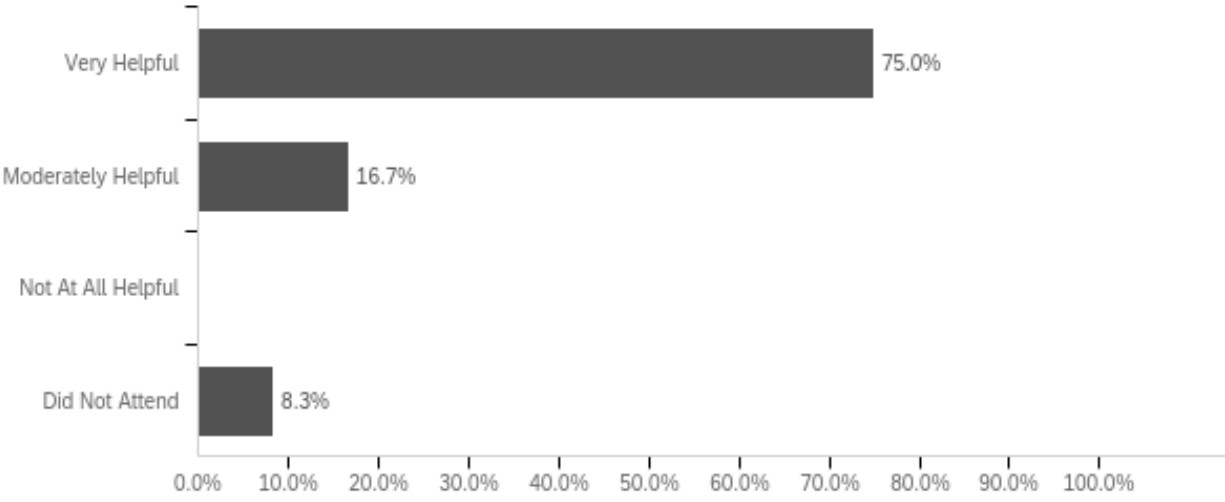
It helped me show the importance of networking, definitely for my career path

# Q11 - Resume Building Workshop



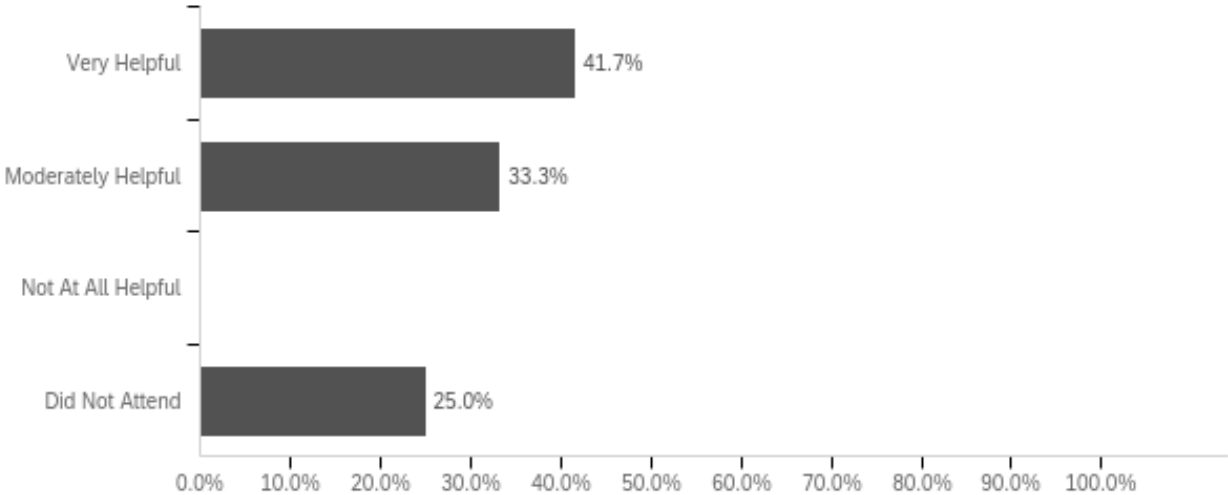
