1. This report is based on employee data as reported to the US Department of Education through the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS). The information shown is from a “snapshot” of persons on the university’s payroll as of November 1 of the
2. The data for 2008 are adjusted from the figures originally reported to IPEDS..
3. No corrections to IPEDS were necessary for full-time employees in 2009. These are the originally reported figures.
4. This report is based on a mandated change instituted by the National Center for Education Statistics as reported to the Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System (IPEDS), beginning fall 2010. The implemented change requires ethnicity/race to be self-identified within a two-question format, in which one’s ethnicity must be answered first and then followed by one’s race. If the employee answers nonresident alien, Hispanic/Latino or 2 or more races, they are not included in race breakout totals.
5. IPEDS allows institutions to report department chairs and other faculty with administrative or other non-instructional duties as either faculty or administrative staff. NKU has historically reported academic chairs, faculty advisors, and academic program directors as non-instructional staff on the IPEDS report. These individuals have faculty appointments at NKU and are now being reported as faculty on other internal documents. Therefore, NKU is reporting these individuals as faculty for the 2014 IPEDS report and forward.
