RECOMMENDATION:

That the Board of Regents approves the revisions to the tuition for the 2018-19 academic year at the rates proposed in the Revised Authorized Schedule of Tuition (attached).

SUMMARY

Undergraduate

A clarification was made to Online to add that it includes both the accelerated and all other online

The rate was adjusted for the School Based Scholars from a course rate of \$156 to a credit hour rate of \$54 for FY2017-18 and \$56 for FY2018-19. The Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority sets the ceiling for the Dual Credit Scholarship program in late June/early July and this rate had not been updated on the original tuition schedule approved by the Board of Regents in May 2018.

Graduate

A separate rate for Online Accelerated (rate for students enrolled through Academic Partnerships agreement) was not provided on the original tuition schedule approved by the Board of Regents in May 2018. For competitive reasons, there is no increase recommended for the Online Accelerated rate for the 2018-19 academic year. The competitive rationale for holding the accelerated online rates flat also extends to the other accelerated online programs listed separately; Master of Business, Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP), and the Master of Science in Nursing. The original tuition schedule had increases of 5%, 3.9%, and 3.9%, respectively for those programs.

The Certificate in Nursing Anesthesia nonresident rate was inadvertently left off of the original tuition schedule. The same increase of 4% that was approved for the resident rate is recommended for the nonresident rate.

NOTE: The above revisions will not have a significant impact on our 2018-19 academic year tuition revenue projections.
