


DRIVER PROTECTION PRODUCTS: Base Rental Charges in the U.S. include the Driver Protection Product(s) below:

CDW FOR BUSINESS RENTALS. For rentals to Customer's employees and agents ("Representatives") for business use who are 21 years old or older only, Base Rental Charges include full CDW (with \$0 Customer retained responsibility) upon the terms and subject to the limitations set forth in Enterprise's then standard form of rental contract ("Rental Contract").

LIABILITY PROTECTION. For rentals to Customer's employees and agents ("Representatives") for business use who are 21 years old or older only, Base Rental Charges include Liability Protection for accidents arising out of the operation or use of the rental vehicle with a combined single limit of \$1,000,000, in either case upon the terms and subject to the limitations set forth in the applicable Enterprise Entity's then standard form of rental contract ("Rental Contract") and in the insurance policy which provides coverage (Liability Protection not available in Puerto Rico). Unless required by law, Liability Protection excludes any protection afforded under: first party benefits; personal injury protection; medical payments; no-fault; and uninsured or underinsured motorist. No coverage is provided for physical damage to, or theft of, the rental vehicle. A Certificate of Insurance naming Customer as an Additional Insured will be issued upon request. Insurer and policy terms subject to change without prior notice to Customer.

ADDITIONAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Rental Program. Enterprise agrees to make its vehicles available to Customer's Representatives for rental from Enterprise's rental factilities for business use.
 Representatives of Customer must use the customer number assigned by Enterprise to Customer (38T2950) when making the reservation for the rental.
- 3. Rental Contracts. For each vehicle rented, the Customer Representative must execute Enterprise's Rental Contract in the jurisdiction in which the vehicle rental occurs. Each Representative (and any person identified on page 1 of the Rental Contract as an "Additional Authorized Driver") must possess a valid driver's license issued by the state in which such person resides, be age 21 or older (unless otherwise agreed to in writing and 18 or older if required by law; and 25 or older for 12 and 15 passenger vans), and meet Enterprise's other normal renter qualifications. In the event of a direct conflict between the terms of this Agreement and the terms of any Rental Contract, the terms of this Agreement will govern. However, the specific terms of each Rental Contract will govern to the extent not directly in conflict with the terms of this Agreement. Customer agrees to pay Enterprise upon demand for all rental and other charges incurred and all indemnity and other payments owed by a Customer Representative under a Rental Contract relating to a rental for business use not timely paid by the Representative.
- 4. Rental Rates. For the first 12 months following the date of this Agreement, Enterprise agrees to charge the Base Rental Charges quoted in this Agreement; provided however that Customer's total payments received by Enterprise reach \$1,000 ("Volume Commitment") during any calendar quarter. In the event Customer's payments to Enterprise fail to meet the Volume Commitment in any calendar quarter, Enterprise reserves the right to increase the Base Rental Charges by providing notice of such increase to Customer. In each successive 12-month period the Base Rental Charges then in effect shall increase by 5.0%. In determining the length of rental, a day is deemed to be any 24-hour period or portion thereof.
- 5. Preferred Provider Status. Customer agrees to promote Enterprise as a preferred provider of rental vehicles, and to recommend Enterprise as an option to Employees and Agents renting vehicles for business use. Customer agrees to include Enterprise as an option on their self-booking tool. In addition, Customer agrees to promote Enterprise on their internal website and through other company-wide internal communication networks. Customer grants Enterprise the

right to promote its preferred provider status to Customer's Employees and Agents.

6. Miscellaneous. Except as otherwise required by law Customer agrees to maintain the confidentiality of the pricing offered to Customer and all other terms under this Agreement. This Agreement and any Rental Contract entered into between Enterprise and Customer sets forth the entire understanding between the parties and may only be amended in a written document signed by each party. This Agreement shall be govered by the substantitive laws of the state listed as part of Customer's address on Page 1. Rental Contracts shall be governed by the substantive laws of the state in which they are executed. Customer authorizes Enterprise to send and herby consents to receive any faxes sent by or on behalf of Enterprise and its affiliates to Customer's fax number.

- 7. Maintenance. Upon three (3) days' prior notification from Enterprise, Customer agrees to make each vehicle available for the purposes of inspection and/or maintenance every thirty (30) days. A contractor of Enterprise will perform preventative maintenance and warranty repairs, at Enterprise's expense. If preventative maintenance and/or repairs are required at a location other than Customer's offices, Enterprise will provide a replacement truck at no additional charge.
- 8. <u>Inspection.</u> Customer agrees to require its Representatives to perform daily visual inspections on rental vehicles including but not limited to the inspection of headlights, running lights, brake lights, and turn signals, the identification and notation of damages and the checking and maintenance of all fluid levels and manufacturer recommended tire pressure. If Customer incurs any minor expense for additional engine oil or as a result of a damaged turn signal, headlight, or fuse, Enterprise will deduct the reasonable amount for such expense from the rental invoice if Customer provides a receipt for such expense.
