During this experiential learning program, you will receive proven frameworks, resources, and networking opportunities to create a hands-on, customized, and integrated educational experience focused on commercialization. This program is designed to equip the next generation of ecosystem builders with the practical skills necessary to lead the translation of Kentucky's most innovative solutions to the real-world market.

The KCV Innovation Fellows program includes bi-weekly cohort meetings held online, independent study with high-quality startup training materials, guided application exercises, and bi-weekly coaching sessions with KCV staff and coaches.

Program Details

- The KCV Innovation Fellowship is open to undergraduate students, graduate students, faculty, and staff of KCV Partner Institutions and affiliated members
- The Spring 2022 pilot program runs March 1 April 30, requiring 5-10 hours/week
- Pilot program participants may qualify for a \$1,000 stipend upon completing the program
