Assist the Center for Innovation & Entrepreneurship (CIE) and help the CIE to accomplish its mission and translate its vision into reality

Charge:

- Members serve as knowledgeable advocates for the CIE in the business community, keeping members of their professional networks informed and updated, as appropriate, on the mission, vision, relevant programs, and relevant opportunities. They promote awareness of the CIE as they interact more broadly with the business and non-business communities.
- Members serve as active listeners to people in the business communities in which they work, advising the CIE Director of any emerging opportunities, challenges, or unexpected perceptions that may impact the CIE.
- Members provide ideas, information, guidance, and judgment that will help the director and the CIE define and refine its short and long term strategies.
- Depending on their interests and expertise, members are encouraged to serve on task forces helping the CIE tackle specific projects. Examples include curriculum revision; branding - communicating a distinctive and compelling identity for the CIE; increasing the efficiency and reliability of employers' access to interns and new graduates; advancing experiential learning; outreach to K-12 students via camps and other programs; and exploration of new and sustainable models of funding.
- Members advise the CIE on its strategic communications, critiquing outward-facing publications (print and online) and working to increase press coverage when possible.
- Members advise and -when appropriate- assist the director in making connections to individuals and companies who may become donors to the CIE and its programs.
- Members place the CIE among their philanthropic priorities.
- If suitable occasions arise, members will introduce the CIE Director to community members who are able to help advance the mission of the CIE.

Membership Guidelines:

Members are chosen from the business, university and entrepreneurial community.

Membership Appointment: Members are appointed by the CIE Director.

Membership Terms: Members serve at the pleasure of the CIE Director, but a

typical term is three (3) years.
