

PRESIDENTS DATA TEAM COMMITTEE

Purpose:

To approach institutional questions in a holistic and collaborative way. To pull individuals from various areas of the institution with data expertise and have them work together to examine institutional problems or questions around student success.

Charge:

This small team is tasked with helping to facilitate transforming NKU into a data informed institution. Contrary to a data driven environment where data is the only element used for decision making, a data informed campus heavily weights the influence of data in the decision making process but still allows for professional judgement, personal experiences, experimentation, and best practices. This committee is charged with developing actionable insights from their analysis. It is not enough to identify problems, this group must be willing to offer solutions to improve institutional performance and enhance student success outcomes. This committee should be involved in activities such as, but not limited to:

- Examining institutional research questions in a holistic and collaborative manner with a focus on student success and actionable insights.
- The integration of the various data systems utilized on campus in order to build comprehensive data sets containing the key data elements for examining these institutional questions.
- Build strategic recommendations based on the results of these analyses.
- Communicate findings of such analyses across multiple levels of the institutional hierarchy, engaging various stakeholders across campus.
- Help to identify functional needs or gaps in terms of analytical insight across the institution.
- Beta test new analytical tools.
- Research “best practices” for relevance on this campus and to ensure return on investment (ROI) for anything currently implement or on-going.
- Promote analytics at an executive and senior management level
