Spring 2015 Final Enrollment Executive Summary Northern Kentucky University Office of Institutional Research April 13, 2015

The Spring 2015 term for Northern Kentucky University began on Monday January 12, 2015; the data represented in this summary and accompanying charts reflect enrollments through the close of business on March 20, 2015, which is the fourth and final CPE census date for spring reporting. The census date was December 16, 2014, for the Winter term; the first eight-week term census date was January 16, 2015; the 16-week full term census date was January 21, 2015; and the final CPE census date was March 20, 2015. There were 88 unique students added to the final official spring enrollment total who are enrolled solely in the second eight-week term. Overall Enrollment:

- IR works with Enrollment Management to validate overall enrollment from the census points with the Enrollment Management Dashboard. As of the second census, there were 79 AELP students, four consortium students, and 147 Gateway2NKU students. These 230 students are not reported to CPE.
- Type I Final Enrollment (all four census dates) is 13,854, which is a decrease of 241 students, or -1.7%, compared to Spring 2014.
- Undergraduate enrollment of 11,973 is a decrease of 33 students compared to Spring 2014.
- Graduate enrollment of 1,489 is a decrease of 124 students, or -7.7%, compared to Spring 2014.
- Law enrollment of 392 is a decrease of 84 students, or -17.6%, compared to Spring 2014.
- Overall enrollment diversity continues to shift to two or more races. There were 22 fewer African American students, a -2.4% change, compared to Spring 2014, while the number of Hispanic students grew by 34, a 10.5% increase, and the number of students claiming two or more races increased by 36, a 17.3% increase. Enrollment of white, non-Hispanic students decreased by 170 students, or -1.5%, compared to Spring 2014.
- The number of students from Ohio or Indiana who received out-of-state tuition reciprocity decreased by 61, or -7.8%. The number of out-of-state students without reciprocity decreased by 155. The total number of students from Hamilton County, Ohio, decreased by 131.
- The largest Kentucky county increases are from Pendleton (+28), Boone (+28), and Oldham (+16), while the largest decreases were from Campbell (-87) and Owen (-13) counties.
- Top declared undergraduate majors for Spring 2015 include: Organizational Leadership, Computer Information Technology, Nursing, Biological Sciences, and Social Work.
- Average credit hours did not change from last spring to this spring, remaining at 11.5.
- The total remedial credit hours decreased by 19.4% compared to Spring 2014.
- The total online credit hours increased 3.7% compared to last spring.
- Overall retention, including all students from Fall 2014 who returned Spring 2015 (removing students who graduated), is 87.4%.





