Faculty Development Awards granted in 2014-2015

Fellowships: 30 applications; 15 funded for total of \$90,000

Project Grants: 26 applications (\$139,783); 13 funded for total of \$60,570 (out of \$72,251 requested)

Sabbaticals: 30 applications; 24 awarded (out of 24 available)

Current year's budget for 2015-2016 awards

Fellowships: 15 awards are available at \$6,000 per award; \$90,000 total

Project Grants: \$56,000 available; up to \$6,000 per grant

Sabbaticals: 24 available for 2016-17. Based upon a calculation of 8% of (full time tenured plus 1/6

tenure-track faculty).
