## Brief Overview of FDA

Faculty Development Awards granted in 2016-2017

Fellowships: 20 applications; 15 funded for total of \$90,000 (out of 15 available) Project Grants: 21 applications (\$95,232.64); 13 funded (total award given \$66,600)

Sabbaticals: 17 applications; 15 awarded (out of 24 available)

Current year's budget for 2017-18 awards – see Old Business Provost approval of FDA increase

Fellowships: 18 awards are available at \$6,000 per award; \$108,000 total Project Grants: 15 awards are available at up to \$6,000 per grant: \$90,000 total

Sabbaticals: 21 available based upon a calculation of 8% of (full time tenured plus 1/6 tenure-track

faculty).
