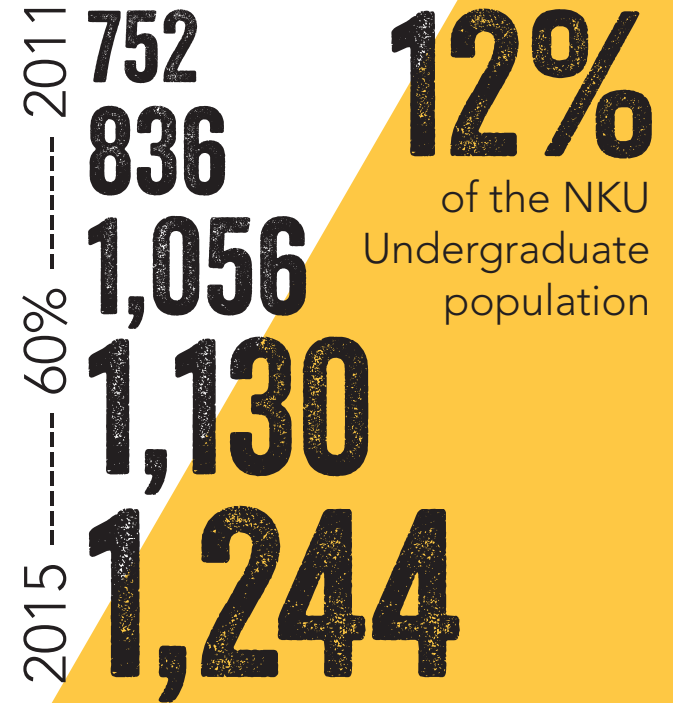

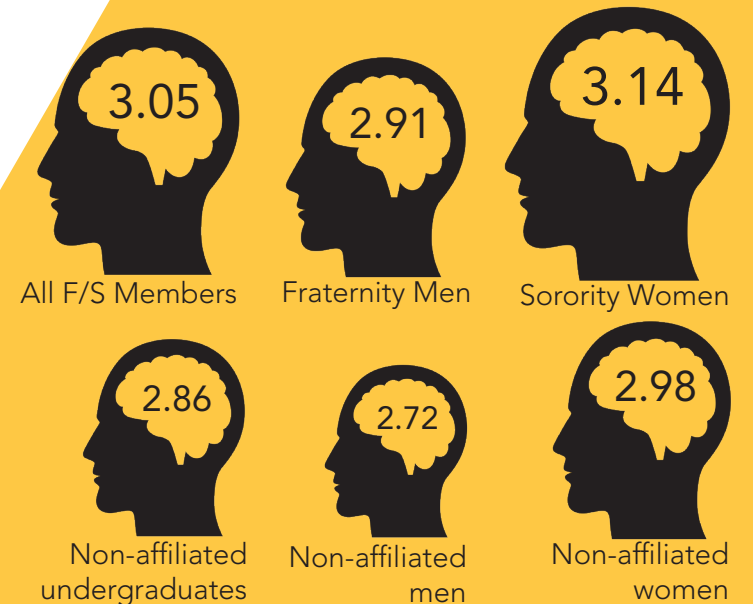


Above a 3.5 GPA

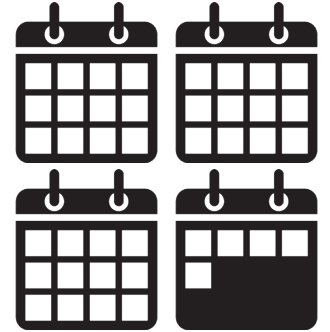

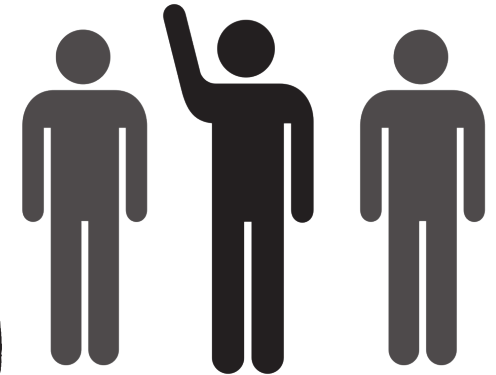
