

EMERGENCY IN CASE OF

REMAIN CALM AND FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS

FIRE – EVACUATE IMMEDIATELY



- Activate the nearest fire alarm and call 9-1-1 if possible. If there are no fire alarms, knock on doors and yell “fire” as you exit the building.
- Evacuate the building.
- Do not use elevators!
- Feel closed doors with the back of your hand. Do not open if doors are hot.
- Move well away from the building once evacuated.

BOMB THREAT/EXPLOSION/SUSPICIOUS OBJECT



- Call 9-1-1, providing as much detail as possible.
- Evacuate the area.
- As you evacuate, look around for anything suspicious.
- Do not touch or disturb any suspicious items.

HAZARDOUS MATERIALS



- If an emergency develops or if anyone is in danger, call 9-1-1.
- Move away from the site of the hazard to a safe location.
- Follow the instructions of emergency personnel.
- Alert others to stay clear of the area.
- Notify emergency personnel if you have been exposed to the hazard or have information about the release.

CAMPUS WARNING SIRENS



- Seek shelter; get inside.
- Shut all doors and windows.
- Stay away from exterior windows.
- Seek information: call 859.572.7777 or check nku.edu.

SEVERE WEATHER



- Monitor local TV/radio for updates.
- Listen for warning sirens.
- If necessary, take shelter. Preferred shelter areas include:
 - Lower levels.
 - Interior rooms and hallways.
 - Avoid objects which could be thrown.

SOUND OF GUNSHOTS



- Assess the situation, utilize the safest of the following options:
 - RUN: If you can safely leave, do so.
 - HIDE: Find a safe place, lock the door, and turn off any lights.
 - FIGHT: Use a last resort, try to incapacitate the attacker.
- Call 9-1-1 when safe to do so.
