

Good afternoon,

As we prepare for opening and move-in, we want to create an environment that prioritizes social distancing and protects the health and wellness of our students and guests. To that effect, move-in will look different this year than it has in previous years. Please read the following information carefully.

Students will only be able to arrive for move-in through pre-scheduled move-in appointments. The link to sign up for a move-in appointment is below in this email. Move-in will occur from August 10-16 and no more than 30 students will be allowed to arrive on campus each hour (20 arrivals per hour in Boothe Village, 10 arrivals per hour in East Village.) ***Please do not arrive during a time other than your scheduled arrival time. If you do not have an appointment or arrive at a time that you did not schedule, you may be turned away until there is availability to check you in.***

Move-in appointments on August 10 are reserved for the following groups of students:

- Honors Living-Learning Community in Callahan Hall. (Honors students who live on campus but are not a part of the LLC will not receive an early move-in appointment.) Honors students who are in the LLC received an email on Thursday, July 24, 2020 from the Honors College.
- R.O.C.K.S. students (The link to sign up for move-in will come from the program director on Monday, July 27, 2020.)
- LAMP students (The link to sign up for move-in will come from the program director.)
- SGA Students and students who work in the Student Union (The link to sign up for move-in will come from Sarah Aikman.)

Some international students will begin arriving on campus on July 27 and are encouraged to contact housing@nku.edu to make arrival arrangements with our staff. There is a required quarantine of 14 days after arriving in the United States. Most international students will be able to quarantine in their Fall assignment, but some may have a temporary assignment for quarantine until their Fall room is ready.

Students will be limited to no more than 2 adult helpers during move-in. No children will be permitted in the residence halls. Any guests beyond the 2 adult helpers will need to remain in the vehicle while the student moves in. After moving in, guests should immediately depart campus. As a reminder, visitation by all guests (including family, friends, and other students) is restricted for this academic year.

All persons must wear a mask while on campus, including during the entire move-in process. Students and guests without masks may be turned away or asked to leave campus if they fail to wear a mask at all times. Masks may only be removed in personal bedrooms and bathrooms.
