I. Two Factor Authentication	Bert Brown	<p>Bert shared our current authentication practices and current tools used to try and prevent cheating. While they are closely related issues, authentication is its own topic as per SACS and the Higher Education Opportunity Act of 2008 which are steering universities to two factor authentication.</p> <p>Two factor authentication options include biometrics, personal response questions, texting/emailing a code to someone, and proctoring.</p> <p>The eLearning sub committee headed by Shannon Eastep will look at options and bring ideas/recommendations back to the ITAC group.</p>
II. IT Major Projects Overview	Nick Pearson	<p>Nick gave a high level view of all of the major projects that IT has been involved with or is currently involved with (over 100 in total). Examples include Academic Partnerships, Canvas, Graduate Planning, and the Health Innovations Center.</p>

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III. Health Innovations Center Update	Nick Pearson	<p>Nick gave an update on the building progress for the new Health Innovations Center. There are over five miles of cable in the building, 61 academic spaces and at least 3 computer labs. The building is currently on target from a timeline perspective.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Early November Founder's Hall construction will be completed. ■ March 2018, substantial completion with planned occupation ■ May 2018, being people moving into building ■ May 2018, a limited number of classes can begin in the building ■ Fall 2018, fully open for classes
