The Great PDF Purge

NKU IT and Marketing & Communications are again partnering for the <u>"Great PDF Purge."</u> In this digital age, increasing importance should be placed on uploaded files. PDFs are often the hardest file type for screen readers to read and the most difficult to remediate; please disable and then delete outdated files. Our <u>PDF Purge decision tree</u> is a strong starting point in your deletion efforts. Please implement the PDF cleanup in three easy phases:

Phase 1: File Deletion in the Digital Asset Manager

Phase 2: Convert PDFs to Webpage Content (where appropriate)

Phase 3: Ensure the Accessibility of all PDFs

Remember, old documents left in the AEM dam can still be found in Google searches. To prevent outdated information from being distributed, deactivate and then delete outdated information. Please submit a <u>service request</u> for assistance. Marketing & Communication and the IT Accessibility team look forward to helping you!
