Over the past two months, NKU's Office of Information Technology has been communicating to ask everyone on campus to migrate their wireless devices to NORSE\_NET (or NORSE\_GUEST when applicable).

This is a reminder that at 7:30 am ET Monday, October 18th NKU\_ENCRYPTED and NKU\_PUBLIC will be retired from service and no longer available. If you haven't yet transitioned, you will need to connect to either NORSE\_NET or NORSE\_GUEST for wireless network connectivity. Please remember that the Guest network is intended for short-term internet-only access.

No exceptions can be made for continued use of the retired NKU wireless networks. IT will be happy to assist you or your office with the migration, or with questions. This does not affect wired device connections.

If you have not already migrated, please find time this week to prevent potential disruptions to your online connectivity.
