ERP Update

NKU has released a Request for Proposal (RFP) to choose our next ERP(Enterprise Resource Planning) platform. This platform will include Human Resources, Finance, Student Information System and Reporting/Analytics. This will replace the existing myNKU system you are familiar with. The RFP was issued October 1, with responses due by November 1, 2024. Additional and periodic updates will be provided through the course of the RFP evaluation, and opportunities will be provided to staff and faculty to participate in demonstrations of software under consideration.

WebEx Phone Migration

Webex Calling is the cloud-based/next-generation version of the Cisco calling platform NKU has historically used. Over the 2024-2025 school year, NKU Telecommunications will be transitioning faculty and staff to this new phone system.

In order to activate Webex Calling, you must first [download the Webex App](#) on your computer or mobile device.

During this transition phase, Webex **DOES NOT** support 4-digit dialing on outbound calls (this will be resolved once all NKU faculty/staff are switched over). Other NKU users (not yet transitioned to the Webex system) will be able to dial you using a 4-digit extension, but you will need to dial other NKU extensions using the full 10-digit number.

The best way to reach other NKU users remains using Channel to Channel communication within Teams.

Please note that NKU will continue to use Microsoft Teams and Zoom for video conferencing. Webex will be designated solely for phone calls. For additional
