

# PROGRAM DETAILS

- Gateway2NKU is a dual-admission program. Students: • Apply for the program (as NKU non degree-seeking students) while enrolled at Gateway THEN apply to transfer to NKU in their last semester
  - Follow a pathway guide

Program benefits. Students:

- Are assigned an advisor at both institutions
- Can use resources & attend events at both institutions
- Take up to 4 NKU courses at Gateway's rate • Can apply to live on NKU's campus
- Can purchase a discounted NKU parking pass



# PROGRAM DETAILS

To apply:

- Be enrolled in at least 6 credit hours at Gateway
  Be enrolled in an associate degree program (AA, AS,
- Be enrolled in an a AAS, etc.)
- Plan to transfer to NKU
- Submit an online Gateway2NKU application (an NKU non degree-seeking app specifically for this program)

To remain:

- Work with advisors to take proper courses
  Maintain a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA at
- Maintain a minimun community college

STA 251 equates to STA 205 only with the completion of MAT 151 or MAT 161.



### GCTC AS TO NKU BS IN HEALTH INFORMATICS CHECKLIST

### NKU COURSES - ELIGIBILITY

Students must be enrolled in at least 6 hours at Gateway to take an NKU course. Courses should be unique to NKU (no Gateway equivalent). Classes must also fit into the Gateway degree (program applicability) for financial aid to apply. Students should work with NKU advisors to register.

Course #1

15-29 earned non-developmental/co-requisite credit hours

Course #2

30-44 earned non-developmental/co-requisite credit hours

### Courses #3 and #4

45+ earned non-developmental/co-requisite credit hours

Once a credit hour limit has passed, students cannot go back and take a course they have missed. (There can be exceptions to this rule.)

### Textbooks


to use financial aid for books



• Financial Aid Consortium Form - must be completed if student wants aid

• Students who receive aid can use their refund to pay their NKU bill

• May be ordered through the home institution's bookstore if students wish



### NKU COURSES - TRANSFER

At the beginning of their last semester at Gateway, students should begin the transfer process:

- Apply online at apply.nku.edu (app fee waived!)
- Apply for scholarships
- Add NKU to the FAFSA

- Sign up for new student orientation (fee waived!)

• Submit official transcripts from all previously attended institutions

• Sign up for programs like Student Support Services, PAC, etc. • Fill out any applicable program specific applications, once admitted
