Strategic Planning Process Update

President Mearns has led an extensive strategic planning process during the spring semester. A few highlights include:

Open Forums — Over 500 participants attended 10 open forums.

Work groups — Seven work groups composed of 112 faculty, staff, and students diligently worked on assigned topics.

Mission, vision, and values survey — There were 990 responses from faculty and staff, which was an overall response rate of 47%, and the response rate for full-time faculty and staff was 57%. We received responses from 1,877 students (14% response rate).

External group meetings — President Mearns has met with 20 external groups, including alumni, HR leaders, CEOs of regional businesses, the Joint Chambers of Commerce, city/county officials, superintendents, and other external stakeholders.

2012-13 Progress Evaluation & Reporting

By **June 30**, you should change the "active through" date to 2012-13 for any goal, outcome/objective, measure, or target that you do not want to continue for the 2013-14 year. Remember to end elements from the bottom up, starting with the target, then the measure, and lastly the objective, so that you do not create orphans.

If you do not complete changes before the new cycle is created, don't worry. Please feel free to contact Planning & Performance, and we can walk you through the process.

By **August 15**, you should have the following steps completed for the 2012-13 planning cycle:

- Enter your findings for each of your measures/targets.
- Answer the four questions under the Achievement Summary/Analysis.
- Develop action plans for how you will make improvements next year on objectives with targets not met or partially met.
- Identify other action plans you may have for objectives in which targets were met.
- Check that all your 2012-13 outcomes/objectives are associated to one of the strategies in the *Points of Focus:* 2012-14 Integrated Strategic Plan.
- Check that your 2012-13 outcomes/objectives are linked to the Diversity Implementation Plan for 2011-13, where appropriate.
- Check that your 2012-13 outcomes/objectives are linked to the Dashboard Indicators, where appropriate.

When you are finished, you may want to run a **Detailed Assessment Report** to review your work. You can check a box to get the output in a *Word* file rather than as a PDF document so that you can save it for future editing, if you prefer.

Change in Planning Timeline for 2013-14

To accommodate the alignment of 2013-14 unit plans with the new strategic plan, the due date has been moved to **December 1, 2013**. After final approval at the November Board of Regents meeting, the 2013-18 Strategic Plan will be loaded to WEAVEonline so that units can establish their associations to it.

While developing unit goals and objectives during the fall semester, departments and administrative units will be able to reference the preliminary version of the 2013-18 Strategic Plan which will be distributed in September. All areas are asked to finalize 2013-14 unit goals and objectives that support the 2013-18 Strategic Plan by December1, 2013.
