I. POLICY STATEMENT

In accordance with KRS §164.375, Northern Kentucky University prohibits any action or situation which recklessly or intentionally endangers mental or physical health or involves the forced consumption of liquor or drugs for the purpose of initiation into or affiliation with any organization. Penalties for violation of the above policy shall include but are not limited to the following:

- 1. Student violators will be subject to suspension or expulsion from the University or other appropriate disciplinary action in accordance with the Code of Student Rights and Responsibilities.
- Faculty and staff violators will be subject to possible loss of employment or other appropriate disciplinary action in accordance with the Faculty Policies and Procedures Handbook, Salmon P. Chase College of Law Faculty Handbook, Handbook for Department Chairpersons, and Personal Policy and Procedures Manual.
- 3. Faculty, staff, or student organizations which authorize actions which violate this policy shall lose University authorization to operate on campus property.
- 4. Visitors, licensees, and invitees to Northern Kentucky University who violate this policy will be ejected from University property and may be subject to prosecution.
