School-Based Scholars (SBS) is Northern Kentucky University's dual-enrollment program that offers eligible high school students the opportunity to take college classes for dual credit at a reduced tuition rate. We serve public school, private school and homeschool students from the northern Kentucky region and beyond. Our students can take classes at their high school (if offered), online and/or at our Highland Heights campus.

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

School-Based Scholars is open to high school sophomores, juniors and seniors who have an unweighted high school GPA of 3.0 or higher. Students must also meet any course prerequisites.

Note: Sophomores may only enroll in the courses offered at their high school (where applicable). Some exceptions may apply.

APPLY TO THE SCHOOL-BASED SCHOLARS PROGRAM

Students who meet the above requirements will need to submit the following materials:

- Online application
- Disclosure form
- High school transcript

Note: Submission of application does not guarantee admission. The SBS office will work with qualifying students on course registration after admission to the program.
