

SBS High School Teacher Interview Prep

Purpose:

- To assist academic departments, as invited, in interviewing pre-approved high school instructors to teach in the SBS program.

Expectations to outline:

- Outline that the instructor will:
 - Complete in the SBS Faculty Orientation and attend any necessary follow up meeting to address key topics, questions, and other considerations when it comes to teaching NKU courses.
 - Submit grades and other course materials at the deadlines specified by NKU, their academic department, and/or the SBS program throughout each semester.
 - Utilize their NKU email address as a primary form of contact with NKU/SBS.
- Does the teacher have any questions about these requirements?

Possible interview questions:

- Why are you interested in teaching dual credit?
- In what ways will you differentiate your dual credit course(s) from your high school courses? (Could be content, pedagogical changes, branding, etc.)
- Students in dual credit may come across unique challenges as they have one foot in the high school world and one in the college world. How do you go about solving student issues? Give examples.
- The university and SBS program are committed to building a culturally diverse and inclusive environment. How would you further this goal?
- In the SBS program, high school counselors play a big role in communicating and managing the program with our students. Please describe your working relationship with your high school counselor. Do you feel that you would be able to maintain a strong working relationship with your counselor if you were teaching in this program?
