

A RESOLUTION OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY, HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY, REQUESTING THE UNIVERSITY ADD RECYCLING BINS NEXT TO EVERY TRASH RECEPTACLE WHERE THERE CURRENTLY ARE NOT ANY LOCATED, ALLOWING FOR THE EXPANSION OF RECYCLING OF GLASS, PLASTIC, AND CANS.

WHEREAS: There are few outdoor recycling bins on campus, other than those around the Student Union and Griffin Hall and the two recycling dumpsters in the Residential Village, and

WHEREAS: There are currently receptacles designated for recycling placed next to the majority of indoor trash receptacles, creating a disparity between the amounts of encouragement towards indoor and outdoor recycling practices respectively, on NKU's campus, and

WHEREAS: In the last 12 months, NKU has recycled over 145 tons of materials (glass, plastic, cardboard, paper, various metals, etc.), and

WHEREAS: The University, a signatory to the American College and University Presidents Climate Committee, should be eager to further expand its recycling program and reduce its carbon footprint.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, on this 30th day of January 2012, the Student Government Association requests the University add recycling bins next to every trash receptacle where there currently are not any located, allowing for the expansion of recycling of glass, plastic, and cans.
