




A RESOLUTION OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY, HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY, REQUESTING THE EXPLORATION OF FUNDING OPTIONS TO CREATE WIRELESS PRINTING ACCESS ON CAMPUS.

- WHEREAS: NKU has no form of wireless printing on campus, with a high need of printing from students and limited university computer lab resources, and
- WHEREAS: An estimated 80% of students have laptops and/or smart phones that would allow them to access wireless printing, and
- WHEREAS: Students with mobile devices would be allowed to access and use specific school applications, and
- WHEREAS: The University's computer laboratory resources would be freed up by allowing more students to do their work and access school applications from their mobile devices, and
- WHEREAS: University computer laboratories experiencing low traffic can be converted to meet the needs of the university, and
- WHEREAS: The cost of replacing and upkeep of university laboratories would be reduced, possibly saving the university money in the future, and
- WHEREAS: The majority of the hardware required to operate wireless printing access is currently in place, and
- WHEREAS: A more convenient, accessible and flexible work environment would be created for students and staff, while freeing up university resources

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, on this 31 day of October 2011, the Student Government Association is requesting NKU explore options to fund the creating of wireless printing access on campus.
