

**A RESOLUTION OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY, HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY, REQUESTING THE CREATION OF A BIENNIAL STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION BOOK DRIVE TO BENEFIT THE NKU LENDING LIBRARY**

WHEREAS: The NKU Lending Library is a service provided for NKU students via University Connect and Persist (UCAP), and

WHEREAS: The NKU Lending Library allows students to check out one textbook per semester free of charge and also provides students with a financial and academic wellness check, and

WHEREAS: Currently, many students will keep or sell back textbooks for nominal amounts of money instead of donating them to the NKU Lending Library, and

WHEREAS: A donation drive, which would occur at the end of the Fall and Spring semesters, on behalf of the NKU Lending Library would provide students with a way to discard their used textbooks in a way that would directly benefit their fellow students, and

WHEREAS: Programs like the NKU Lending Library are always accepting donations to broaden and enhance their ability to serve students, and

WHEREAS: An SGA sponsored textbook donation drive would improve the NKU Lending Library and the student experience in a variety of ways including but not limited to: providing publicity for the program, providing more textbooks for students to use, and increasing the likelihood that a student who uses the NKU Lending Library will be able to save money by renting a free book, and

WHEREAS: The book drive may be coordinated at the discretion of future NKU Student Government Associations.
