

A RESOLUTION OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY, HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY, SUPPORTS THE PROPOSED CAMPUS MASTER PLAN FOR THE EXTENSION AND CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS TO EXTEND FROM THE UNIVERSITY SUITES TO CAMPBELL HALL.

WHEREAS: There is currently no sidewalk extending from the University Suites to Campbell Hall for students to safely get from the Boothe Residential Village to Campbell Hall, and

WHEREAS: During the 2016 Fall SGA Safety Walk, students raised awareness regarding the lack of a safe route to Campbell Hall, and

WHEREAS: The Director of Campus Planning, Mary Paula Schuh, confirmed that the extension of the sidewalks would be included in the Connector Road Project as seen in the Master Plan of 2009, and

WHEREAS: The Connector Road Project will ensure that sidewalks are available for students and that students have a safe route to and from the Boothe Residential Village to Campbell Hall, and

WHEREAS: The Connector Road Project was proposed in the Master Plan of 2009, the Master Plan included the construction of the sidewalks scheduled to begin within the next year, and

WHEREAS: As the Student Government Association we need to guarantee the extension of these sidewalks to eliminate safety hazards for all students.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, ON THIS TWENTY-SEVENTH DAY OF MARCH 2017, THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY SUPPORTS THE PROPOSED PLAN FOR THE EXTENSION AND CONSTRUCTION OF SIDEWALKS TO EXTEND FROM THE UNIVERSITY SUITES TO CAMPBELL HALL.
