WHEREAS: Dr. Herschede has served the University from 2006 to the present, and

WHEREAS: While serving the University Dr. Herschede has held the staff positions of: Executive Assistant to the President, Secretary to the Board of Regents, and Director of Government and Community Relations, and

WHEREAS: Dr. Herschede has been honored with numerous awards which have brought great distinction to herself and the University. The most notable including: The 2016 Torch Award, the 2012 Next Generation Leader Award, the 2007 Phi Sigma Sigma Pyramid Award, and the 2005 Robert G. Thurber Award, and
