

A RESOLUTION OF THE STUDENT GOVERNMENT ASSOCIATION OF NORTHERN KENTUCKY UNIVERSITY, HIGHLAND HEIGHTS, KENTUCKY, CALLING FOR REMINDER LIGHTSWITCH LABELS

WHEREAS: Some buildings used to (and may still) have light switch labels reminding students, faculty, staff, and visitors to turn off lights in vacant rooms in campus facilities, and

WHEREAS: The Sustainability Operations Coordinator and Facilities Management, have previously discussed adding more light switch labels around campus, but have not initiated this project, and

WHEREAS: An audit of all campus buildings, **except for the dormitories and eateries** in Boothe and East Village, has been performed, and

WHEREAS: The rooms and buildings with automatic motion sensor lights will not be involved in the process of adding reminder labels, such as Founders Hall and the Health Innovation Center, and

WHEREAS: The buildings with **manual light switches**, such as Albright Health Center, Business Academic Center, Fine Arts Center, Griffin Hall, Landrum Hall, Lucas Administration Center, Math Education Psychology Center, Nunn Hall, Science Center, Student Union, University Center will be included in the process, and

WHEREAS: To reach the desired aesthetic appeal, a design is being created and will be presented to the University Committee Chairperson when complete for approval and implementation, and

WHEREAS: We believe the addition of reminder labels will aid in forming a habit for university stakeholders to turn off the lights when they leave a vacant room, thus helping conserve energy, reduce harmful greenhouse gas emissions, and save the University money in energy costs.
