 - b. **NOTES ABOUT x92 COURSES:**
 - i. Have programs and departments continue with regular process for creating any new x92 course (i.e., there will be no mass form or memo); preference is for courses to be numbered 392 or 492, but can use an existing course (e.g., 292)
 - ii. There is not yet any information about the desired number of credit hours for these courses and there is not yet a deadline for the development of these courses, we can still create them after the March deadline for fall 2019 (they won't be in the catalog, but they can be implemented in SAP)
 - iii. There is not yet a conceptual or operational definition for what constitutes "research" for these courses; consult with the dean of your college
