

Foreign Language Award for International Study

The Foreign Language Award for International Study (FLAIS) is a competitive award and will be given to excellent students of language who apply for the award and meet the following criteria:

1. Applicant must be enrolled in or have completed at least the 102 level at NKU in the language being pursued abroad and must be enrolled at Northern Kentucky University.
2. Applicant must be accepted and participate in a study-abroad program approved by the NKU Office of Education Abroad. If a student has not received an official acceptance in time for the FLAIS deadline, s/he/they may still apply for an award. If the applicant is selected for an award, it will only be granted once the official acceptance is submitted to the Department Office for consideration by the Awards Committee. Language acquisition must be a major component of the study-abroad program. For study abroad programs besides KIIS, tentative advance approval of credit for courses selected must be received from the Department of World Languages and Literatures.
3. Upon return, student agrees to share his/her study abroad experience with the foreign language students and faculty, via a talk, presentation or article in a university publication.

Amount of Award:

The award(s) will be made in an amount up to \$500.

Applications:

Applications are available from foreign language faculty, the department web site, and in the World Languages and Literatures office (MP 475).

Application Deadlines:

Hard copies of applications are due in the World Languages and Literatures office (MP 475) by 4:00 p.m. on dates posted on line.
