Notes: This plan is ONE way in which you can complete your degree program in four years; it is not the only way. It assumes that you have not had any prior experience in Spanish. If you begin at a level higher than SPI 101, you will be able to take more electives. It also assumes that you are not a transfer student, and you are beginning in the fall. This plan includes a minor of 24 credit hours.

Be sure that you complete at least 45 credits at the 300 level or above. This means you must take at least 18 credits at the 300 level or above in your major, minor or electives outside the major/minor.

*Courses 300 level or above must include SPI 304, either SPI 401 or SPI 402, one SPI 480 and one SPI 481 course, two literature courses and two culture courses plus one elective. These courses may be taken in any order provided that prerequisites have been met.
